St Mary's Church repairs

For two months from March 1st, repairs will be carried out to stonework, lead-work, gutters, down-pipes and drains on the south side of the church. The south porch will also be renovated, including new leaded lights in the windows. The south side of the church will be scaffolded, but there will be no disruption to services. The floodlights will be turned off on Saturday 27th

March. This is in support of "Earth Hour" a WWF initiative started in 2007 which specifically shows concern for climate change by turning off lights on major buildings and places around the world. St Mary's is normally so visible when floodlit, that
