PS2 Console and/or games (12 or under), Funky lights, Pool / table football, Toastie makers, Screen / white canvas or tarpaulin.

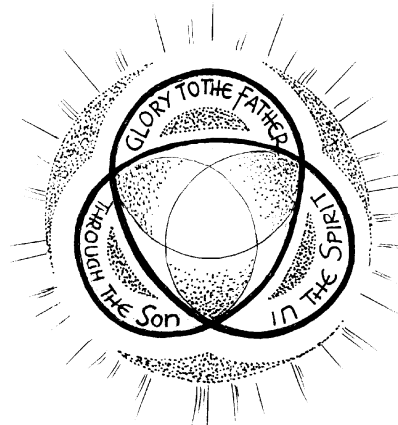
